The aim of the webinar-series is to communicate with and showcase our members among our global community of positive psychology students. The webinar series is a popular offering for students and the wider IPPA community of life-long learners.

The Student Speaker Series Lead's's responsibilities include, but are not limited to, the following tasks:

- Organising quarterly webinars featuring SIPPA members and their research
- Promoting SIPPA membership and activities
- Helping to build the positive psychology community by actively engaging with, contributing to, and sharing content
- Sharing ideas of how to foster and maintain a strong SIPPA community
- Attending monthly meetings with the SIPPA Executive Leadership Team
- Reaching out to current IPPA students to schedule webinars with them
- Proactively developing skills in available technology to help facilitate webinars
- Interviewing positive psychology students on recorded webinars
- Obtaining and using feedback from webinars to improve future events
